**A FURTHER £24 WILL HAVE TO BE PAID BY THE QUALIFYING
FENCERS ON THE DAY, AS THE ENTRY FEE FOR THE NATIONAL
FINALS.**

RULES FOR QUALIFICATION:

Qualification is calculated on 1 in 4, or part of 4, of those fencers actually fencing in the qualifying competition with a minimum number of 4. This includes fencers eligible for byes. Any fencer who reached the last 8 in their event at last year's BYC finals may claim a bye to this year's finals

in the same weapon regardless of age group. This includes finalists from the U10 events.

FENCERS CLAIMING A BYE MUST ENTER THE REGIONAL QUALIFYING COMPETITION BUT DO NOT NEED TO FENCE. THE FULL ENTRY FEE OF £27 (SE ENTRY) + £24 (BYC FINALS ENTRY) WILL NEED TO BE PAID WITH THE SE ENTRY.

WHO CAN TAKE PART: Fencers must be registered as South East on their BFA membership.

Fencers may only fence in 1 region's event.

Fencers must hold "compete" British fencing membership.

U12 – Born 2006 or 2007

U14 – Born 2004 or 2005

U16 – Born 2002 or 2003

U18 – Born 2000 or 2001

Equipment must comply with current BFA regulations.

U12/14 sabre blades size 2.

U16/18 sabre blades size 5.

U16/18 sabre gloves 800N obligatory.
